Session Eight	Sacred spaces in the Catholic school. Five models through an ECSI lens

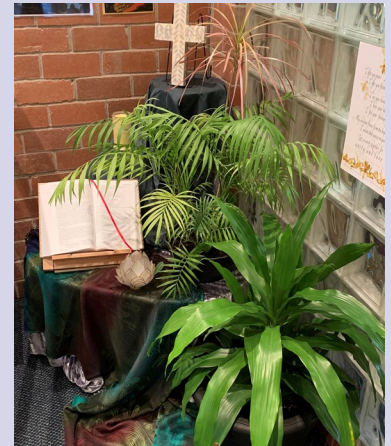
Target Audience / Prerequisites
