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## 2023 NCCD evidentiary requirements guidance

### Main Points

- Schools are required to comply with the [2023 NCCD Guidelines](#) and principals must attest that their school has evidence for the inclusion of students in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD).
- The Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd (CECV) [NCCD Evidentiary Requirements Guidance](#) provides schools with advice to support the streamlined collection of evidence and participation in the quality assurance process for 2023.
- Principals are encouraged to use the document to support their NCCD school teams to engage with the quality assurance process and conduct moderation as outlined in the [NCCD Moderation Resource for Schools](#).
