• as an instructional leader, including an ability to embed a culture of high expectation of student learning and build expert teacher practice which is evidence-based, high impact and inclusive.

Leading improvement

• for strategic leadership focusing on leadership for school improvement, and an ability to design and implement high leverage improvement plans.

Leading the management of the school

• to ensure that the school's human, physical and financial resources are efficiently allocated and managed, including ongoing compliance with legislated Child Safe Standards and the Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority.

Engagement

• to develop positive relationships with students; parents and families; the local parish and wider community; and participate and contribute to DOSCEL activities.

• to foster a community which holds high aspirations and expectations maximising opportunities for all students.
