Rationale

Improving Literacy in the Secondary Years (ILSY) for Middle Leaders will guide teachers to explicitly and systematically lead school improvement using a disciplinary literacy approach.

Focus / Learning Intentions

Participants will engage in a series of workshops, team coaching and an action learning project to build disciplinary literacy practices in their own school setting.

- * Understand the development of language and literacy.
- * Reflect on the forms of literacy valued in schools and society.
- * Understand literacy strategies
- * Audit literacy requirements learning areas.
- * Lead teams to build disciplinary literacy practices.
