Learning and Teaching

Rationale

Improving Literacy in the Secondary Years (ILSY) for Executive Leaders has been designed to develop the capabilities of Secondary Principals and Senior Learning Leaders to improve student learning outcomes through a whole school approach to disciplinary literacy.

Focus / Learning Intentions

Leaders will engage in workshops and school embedded activities designed to develop the key knowledge and capabilities required for leading a disciplinary literacy approach. The program is designed and facilitated by leading literacy and leadership experts from the University of Melbourne and is grounded in the latest research and evidence.

Content

- * Literacy and leadership: understanding the literate practices of leaders
- * The importance of disciplinary literacy for whole school improvement
- * Dialogic school leadership: school improvement and literacy
- * Reflecting on school improvement through literacy practices: what is the role of the school leader?
