



Welcome to Term 3!

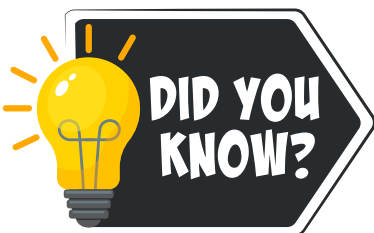
There is plenty happening this term and we hope that School TV will continue to be a valuable resource in supporting your communication with your school communities.
