Circular to principals of Catholic schools in Victoria

Consent and Respectful Relationships Education Principal and Leadership Team Focus Groups

Main Points

- Principals or members of school leadership are invited to participate in one of three in-person focus groups on *Consent and Respectful Relationships* in Term 4.
- The aim of these focus groups is to explore the Consent and Respectful Relationships Curriculum with leaders of Catholic primary and secondary schools and identify the specific needs, challenges and opportunities in Catholic school communities.
- This feedback will inform the development of future tools, materials and resources to support Catholic leaders.
- Sessions will be facilitated by Catholic relationships and sexuality education consultant <u>Caitlin</u>
 <u>Humphrys</u>, and will run for 3.5 hours. In person participation is preferred and light refreshments will
 be provided. Online participation is also welcomed.
- Through these sessions, leaders will be provided with a general overview of Consent and Respectful Relationships Education, its alignment with Catholic values on human dignity and the role that principals and leadership teams play in creating a respectful school culture and building organisational confidence.
- Topics will include cultural considerations, integration of curriculum with pastoral care and wellbeing programs, and support for teachers and staff.
