# Tue 17 Sep

This morning, visit Catherine's House, the first house of Mercy built by Catherine McAuley in response to the needs of the poor of Dublin. It is home to the Mercy family from all over the world. Catherine's House is a Centre of Hospitality, Heritage, Pilgrimage and Renewal. It is a Wellspring of inspiration for those who come to continue Catherine's mission with new life.

This afternoon, you will visit Loreto House, Beaufort Rathfarnham Dublin - Teresa Ball (1794-1861) brought Mary Ward's Institute to Ireland. In 1822 she opened the first house in Rathfarnham and called it "Loreto House". The "Loreto" name was used for all foundations that came from Ireland and the sisters were known as "Loreto Sisters". Under Mother Teresa Ball's leadership, the Loreto Order expanded throughout Ireland and eventually overseas. She founded numerous convents and schools in Ireland, England, India, Canada, Australia, and other countries.

You will then visit Trinity College for the Book of Kells Experience.

# Wed 18 Sep

Today you leave Dublin & make your way out of Dublin to Country Kildare and to St Brigid's, Solas Bhride Centre built in the shape of St Brigid's Cross. Here you will have the chance to follow the mediative walk & pause for reflection at significant points.





Continue to Glendalough and take a guided pilgrimage walk to the Monastic site of St Kevin.

# Thu 19 Sep

This morning make your way through the Wicklow countryside to Callan, the birthplace of Blessed Edmund Rice. Travel on to Wexford & visit the Sisters of St John of God, Ballyvaloo Centre, before continuing to Waterford.

Visit the Edmund Rice international Heritage centre and the final resting place of Blessed Edmund, founder of the Christian & Presentation Brothers. Next up is a visit to the Waterford Crystal Showroom where you can purchase your very own piece of this famous crystal before heading to Cork.

# Fri 20 Sep

This morning you will visit the Cobh Heritage Centre for the 'Queenstown Story' of Irish Emigration. The scattering of the Irish is one of the great migration stories, in Cobh.

You will then visit the Nano Nagle Place, an unexpected oasis in the centre of bustling Cork City, a place that celebrates Nano Nagle's vision of empowerment through education, community inclusion and spiritual engagement for a contemporary world.

This afternoon you will travel through the countryside of County Tipperary.

# Sat 21 Sep

This morning, you will travel to Glenstal Abbey, where a community of Benedictine monks who run a boarding school for boys, pray, work & farm amidst 500 acres of farmland, forest, lakes & streams. Spend some time learning about this community dedicated to St Joseph & St Columba.

Make your way via St Brigids well, to the beautiful Cliffs of Moher for a late lunch, before continuing to Galway.

# Mon 23 Sep

Get started very early today to travel to Croagh Patrick, one of Europe's best-known places of Pilgrimage, that has provided a tough ascent for many pilgrims each year, climbing barefoot in the memory of St. Patrick, who spent forty days and forty nights fasting on the summit more than 1,500 years ago. A small church at the summit of the mountain welcomes penitents, while magnificent views of Clew Bay, with an island for every day of the year, provides inspiration for many walkers and visitors throughout the year.

The climb is 7km and take 3 to 4 hours return and is a moderate to strenuous hike, for those that would like to do it. You would need to be on the hike as early as possible before 9am to avoid the heat and crowds.

This afternoon, stop at Ireland's other famous pilgrimage site, Knock where Our Lady, St Joseph & St John the Evangelist, an altar, cross and a lamb appeared to 15 people, in this small village in 1875.

#### Tue 24 Sep

This morning, you will be crossing into Northern Ireland and on to a new currency, the UK Pound.







Enjoy a private walking tour of the 400-year-old Derry Walls and learn about the 6<sup>th</sup> century history up to the modern-day Troubles, the Apprentice Boys, the Famous Bogside Murals and the 1972 Bloody Sunday massacre.

# Wed 25 Sep

This morning travel to Giants Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage site consisting of over 40,000 hexagonal-honeycomb shaped stepping stones. Continue to Belfast and take a late afternoon unique & riveting journey into the Shankill Road Murals area and learn the stories behind each mural, the People, the neighbourhood and history of this key place. during the great conflict of The Troubles.
