## Confidently promoting and embedding Respectful Relationships in Catholic schools

Principals and members of school leadership are invited to attend **one of five sessions** on “Building Leaders, a Consent and Respectful Relationships” workshop, co-designed by Jesuit Social Services’ [The Men’s Project](#).

These sessions aim to build organisational capacity for small teams of school leaders to confidently promote and embed Respectful Relationships.

Schools do not need to be currently signed up to the Respectful Relationships program to attend and can register 2-3 members of leadership.

The all-day workshops will be facilitated by Jesuit Social Services and will:

- Discuss the work of Respectful Relationships in connection with Catholic Social Teachings
- Build knowledge and awareness of the Man Box and the pressures men and boys face
- Enhance the role that school leaders play in creating a respectful school culture
- Build organisational confidence in delivering Consent and Respectful Relationships Education

This one-day training will take place across Victoria in May 2025.
