
What is PageUp?

PageUp is a tailored applicant tracking system designed for DOBCEL. It consolidates and streamlines all stages of the recruitment process within a single, legally compliant platform. From job advertisement to onboarding, schools will be able to:

- Receive, review, and manage applications efficiently,
- Coordinate interviews and selection processes,
- Extend offers and manage employment documentation,
- Onboard new team members effectively.

This platform will ensure consistency and best practice in recruitment across all DOBCEL schools.

Rollout Requirements and Timeline

All DOBCEL schools are required to transition to PageUp by the end of Term 2, 2026. To support this, a series of showcase and training sessions will be offered. While the sessions are organised by geographic zone, schools may attend any session that best aligns with their availability.

Who Should Attend?

Attendance requirements vary by session type:

Showcase Sessions:

Principals and staff members directly involved in recruitment are expected to attend to gain an overview of PageUp and its capabilities.

Training Sessions:

Staff members directly involved in recruitment must attend. This includes those responsible for:

- Preparing and posting job advertisements
- Managing applications (e.g. shortlisting, interviews)
- Handling administrative tasks related to employment offers and documentation

Principals are welcome, but not required, to attend training sessions.
