A bursary administered by YTU has been created to fund studies and research at YTU and CTC. The bursary is named the Therese D'Orsa Mission Education Bursary in recognition of her contribution to the Church and the gift from her estate.

Bursary Criteria

Bursaries will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- increased capacity for missiological thinking and action
- strengthened Catholic Church capability to grow the seeds of the Gospel in Australia
- cultural research on the Australian context for evangelisation
- formation for synodal Church leadership

Entry Requirements

The following are eligible to apply: YTU and CTC coursework students, HDR candidates, honorary researchers/associates, or academic staff. Your Course Advisor will provide a first point of contact to discuss any queries relating to bursaries.

Bursary categories

Bursaries are available in the following areas:

Sponsored Mission Education Units

- Bursaries are available to cover the fees for units that meet the Bursary Criteria.
- Applications must demonstrate how the learning outcomes for the unit will meet the Bursary Criteria and how the unit will build the applicant's missiological or synodal capacity.
- Units with a mission focus or units that support the synodal mission of the church have a strong alignment with the Bursary Criteria and will therefore be considered favourably.

Mission Education SRU / Thesis / Minor Thesis

- A Supervised Reading Unit with learning outcomes in one or more of the Bursary criteria
- A Minor Thesis which contributes to one or more of the Bursary criteria
- A Thesis at Masters, Professional Doctorate or PhD level which contributes to one or more of the Bursary criteria
