
Remove DNS settings from MAC devices.

- 1. Select the network button on the top right corner of the desktop. If you are connected to Wi-Fi it would look something like this: •
- 2. This will open a small drop-down list which should have a network preference at the bottom of the list (I think).
- 3. Once open you will see a screen that looks similar to the below image. Make sure you have the Wi-Fi selected and hit the 'Advanced...' button.



4. The next screen that opens is as per below. Select 'DNS' on the top row then by row select each item in this screen and click the '-' button in the bottom left corner. This will remove the DNS record.
